Bring other patches to trade also. Events will include geocaching, knots, first aid, nature skills,sports events, fun events, shooting sports and camp inspection. Pack 130 Webelos will be invited to join us for the weekend.

CLOTHING: Be prepared for cold and wet weather. Hopefully we will still have some nice days.
